Dear Friends and Partners of Rooted Legacy,

As we reflect on our first year as Rooted Legacy Ministry, we are overwhelmed with gratitude. What began as a step of obedience has grown into a movement of discipleship, generosity, and global partnership.

Because of your prayers, support, and encouragement, God has done more in this first year than we could have imagined.

This year we hosted our first Rooted Legacy conference in partnership with Converse First Baptist Church in Texas, bringing together five local churches for discipleship, leadership, and generational faith training.

We launched our first book in Spanish with Sister Claudia Brown and expanded our discipleship training materials into Swahili in Tanzania. Through this work, Pastor John Tembo was certified as a Rooted Legacy Presenter and Ministry Partner.

Through generous support, we provided Pastor John with two computers after a burglary left him without essential ministry tools. We also assisted with critical vehicle repairs to help keep him on the road serving others.

Together, we helped host a discipleship training event serving over 100 pastors, college students, parents, and youth, introducing our Fight Club discipleship model.

Locally, we partnered with Food for Families in Indian Trail, North Carolina, delivering 72 food-grade storage bins donated by local families to support food security efforts.

Global Missions & Partnerships

Jamaica Outreach – Kilmarnock, Jamaica

In January, Rooted Legacy Ministry partnered with a local ministry serving an underserved village community in Kilmarnock, Jamaica. Through the generosity of supporters and local churches, we delivered and distributed approximately \$4,000–\$6,000 worth of humanitarian aid, essential supplies, and discipleship materials directly to families in need. This outreach strengthened relationships with local leaders while meeting both physical and spiritual needs.

International Men's Conference – Spanish Town, Jamaica

Rooted Legacy Ministry was invited back to Jamaica February 19–22 to participate in a major men's conference in Spanish Town, Jamaica. The event reached approximately 200–300 men both in person and virtually, with participants joining from London, Fort Lauderdale (FL), Ontario (Canada), and the Cayman Islands. The conference focused on biblical leadership, discipleship, fatherhood, and strengthening men to lead faithfully within their homes and communities.

Rooted Legacy Conference – Botswana

This year marked the launch of our first Rooted Legacy conference in Botswana, where representatives from five universities and churches gathered for leadership and discipleship training. The response created new opportunities for ongoing collaboration and future ministry development throughout the region.

Expanding Into Malawi

Rooted Legacy Ministry is now developing a new partnership opportunity in southern Malawi in the region of Mgabu through Pastor Samuel Vinkhumbo, Divine Restoration Church, Ministers Network in Malawi Ministry, and Sola Scriptura Bible School. This partnership opens doors for pastoral training, biblical discipleship, leadership development, and church strengthening initiatives throughout the region.

Year Two Vision

As Rooted Legacy Ministry enters its second year, our focus remains centered on building strong disciples, strengthening families, equipping leaders, and expanding biblical training both locally and globally.

- Expand discipleship and pastoral leadership training in Jamaica, Tanzania, Botswana, and Malawi.
- Develop additional Fight Club discipleship groups and generational mentoring initiatives.
- Continue publishing and translating discipleship resources into additional languages.
- Strengthen partnerships with churches, universities, and ministry leaders focused on biblical discipleship.
- Increase humanitarian outreach efforts that combine practical support with Gospel-centered ministry.
- Launch and grow the 'Reclaiming the Next Generation' training initiative at FBCIT / IT University.
- Equip men, fathers, and young leaders through conferences, workshops, and strategic ministry partnerships.

Rooted Legacy Ministry moves into Year Two with gratitude, humility, and confidence that God will continue to multiply the work being done through faithful partnerships, discipleship, and servant leadership.
